Your child will be loved and respected for being themselves.

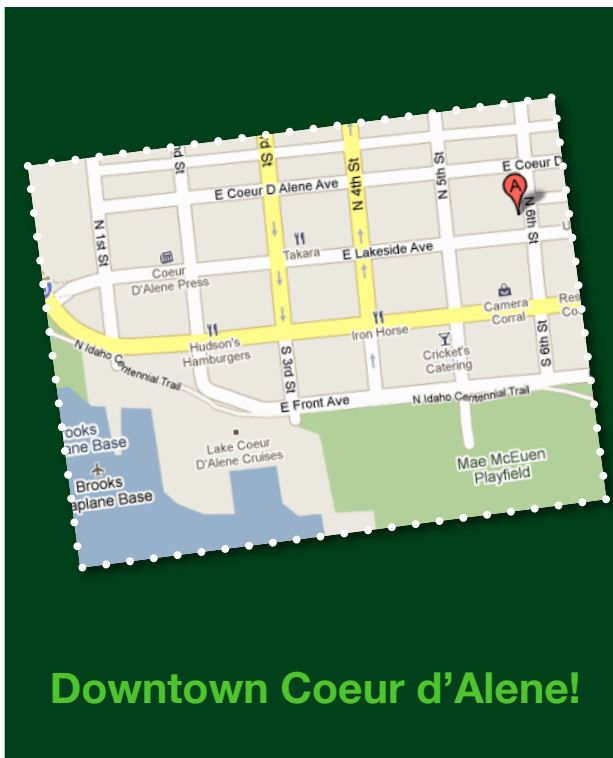
We strive to provide parents the best of both worlds: fun, safe childcare and a preschool environment.
